**Part A**

A good is an actual item. Toys are examples of goods.

Goods are very important. People need food, clothing and homes to be safe. People enjoy goods and use them daily.

*AND*

**Part C**

It would be almost impossible to produce all of the goods we need to survive! If no one produced goods anymore, consumers would have to do without goods that are needed. People who provide services would not be able to do so without the goods they need to provide those services. Even though producers sell goods, they also buy goods from other producers. People are both producers and consumers. It is impossible to have one without the other.
